Keep your eye on the goal!

While surveying for a new road in the country, an engineer noticed that a farmer drove his tractor onto the adjoining field and begin plowing. He couldn't help notice that he started in the middle of the field and went straight across without wavering from one side or another. Being a surveyor, he wondered how the farmer made such a straight row without any instruments. When the farmer returned to the side of the road, the surveyor was waiting to question him. He asked how he was able to make such a straight track across the field without so much as a trial run. The farmer was confused at first, but when he recognized that the surveyor was asking an honest question, he replied "See that tree across the field, I just kept my eye on it and went straight for it."

Reaching a desired goal is as simple as that – keep your eye on that goal and go straight for it. What is your club's goal? Are you keeping your eye on it?

Be sure you haven't set your goal to high. Can you imagine how the farmer might plow straight, if he was keeping his eye on the tree across the county? Set your club's goal logical – aim for what you can accomplish. On the other hand don't sell yourself short – aim for something that is "just out of your reach".

Take a few minutes when you are gathered with your club members to examine your goal. Make a visual reminder, like a sign or a picture and put it up at each meeting to remind you of where you want to go.

Remember this, if you don't set a club goal, your club will just exist to exist. It will have nothing to hope for, or nothing to try to obtain.
